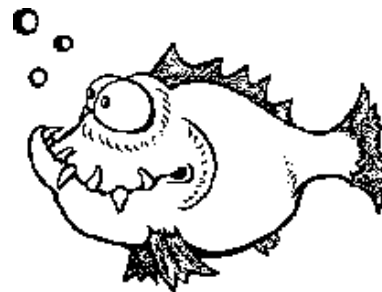

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.

- **No swimmer may enter more than three events or race more than 250m in total, unless they enter a 400m event.**
- **400m swimmers must be 11yrs and over, and may enter one additional 50m event.**
- **You may only enter a 100m event if you are can swim 50m of the same stroke in less than 1m10 for breaststroke or 60sec for all other strokes.**
- Those achieving a Personal Best time will receive a ribbon.
- Club points will be awarded for best times on a percentage basis. The winning club will be presented with the Personal Best Trophy.
- All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules

WARM UP RULES

- Team Managers and Coaches are responsible for swimmers' safety during the warm up.
- Swimmers must swim in their allocated warm up lanes. Lane 2 Tawa, L3 Raumati, L4 Kapiti, L5 Swimmers 14yrs and over, Lane 6 PCA.
- Diving is only permitted in Lane 1 from the start end with turn practise at the other end.
- Swimmers must not swim across the lanes and are to enter and exit the lanes from the either end of the pool only.

*Note: the organisers reserve the right to alter the order and/or combine the 200m & 400m events.
 All clubs are to provide officials as set out below.*

Duty Club:

Pool set up and clear up.
 To arrange two referees, a starter, a marshall and two assistants, a chief timekeeper, two runners and two door people.

All Clubs: Two Inspector of Turns

Visiting clubs: Five timekeepers

Host club: Three timekeepers.
