OBJECTIVES

- To encourage club swimmers to swim competitively in a team environment.
- To give opportunity to parents/supporters to be introduced to poolside officiating
- To foster a healthy team competition between clubs in the Wellington region

Events:

1. 4x25m Breast Relay
2. 50m Backstroke
3. 50m Butterfly
4. 50m Breaststroke
5. 50m Freestyle
6. 4x25m Backstroke Relay
7. 200m Freestyle
8. 4x25m Medley Relay
9. 100m Backstroke
10. 100m Breaststroke
11. 100m Freestyle
12. 100m Ind. medley
13. 10 x 25m Free Relay

Eligibility / Team Selection

- Teams shall consist of up to ten swimmers
- Ideally teams should have a mix of ages [teams can be mix boys & girls]
- All swimmers shall be 12 years or under on the date of first meet of the series
- **Teams are allowed TWO ENTRIES in each event EXCEPT relays and the 200 freestyle, where only ONE entry per team is permitted. All swimmers must swim at least THREE events. Maximum number of swims per swimmer is 2 individual swims, 3 relays, a total of 5 SWIMS.**
- SW's recommendation is to keep same team members for the whole season, however clubs may change members if required. Teams are encouraged to participate in the series of four meets

General Guidelines / Rules / Format

- The series will be swum over four meets over a period not exceeding six calendar months.
- This competition will cater for a maximum of 21 teams. Should this series be over-subscribed all clubs will be allowed one team. The organisers will allocate additional teams in the ratio of registered swimmers, or by ballot.
- Organisation is to be kept as simple as possible.
- Swimming is on a CLUB basis.
- Each meet is to be of short duration (est.2 ½ hrs) including warm up.
- Scoring - Points shall be awarded on a descending scale: 1st place 12 points. 2nd place 11 points etc for each event.
- Clubs must appoint a team manager for each team entered.
- Entries: Race secretaries are to send entries (Proof of Times report, TM file) and a fee report to racesecretary@raumatiswimming.co.nz by **Sunday 18 September 5pm**

- Club entry fees paid by direct bank deposit or electronic payment should be made to 030732-0237257-00 Raumati Swimming Club. Cheques can be posted to; Yvonne Kay, P O Box 2035, Raumati Beach
- All teams must provide poolside officials as rostered by the meet organisers, i.e. TWO time keepers (not necessarily qualified) and ONE IOT.
- A qualified Chief Timekeeper and TWO experienced marshalls are also required from amongst the participating clubs.
- **Club League is to be a learning experience for swimmers and officials. Qualified officials will be officiating and are keen train new people**
- All participating clubs must agree to accept the spirit and the rules of the meet in the interests of fostering developing swimmers.

Disqualification/ Dispensation

- Any team swimming a non registered team member and/or who fails to provide officials will be deemed disqualified and will forfeit all points for the meet.

Note:

The meet organiser may grant dispensation from any of the league requirements PROVIDED that this is not granted AFTER THE EVENT. Dispensation will only be granted in exceptional circumstances.
