CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 This Championship meet is open only to Wellington Affiliated clubs
- 2 All events will be conducted as timed finals under the SNZ rules
- 3 Age of the swimmers will be as at 26 June 2010
- 4 Swimming up an age is permitted in all events **EXCEPT** 1, 14 & 15, which must have actual age group swimmers.
- 5 Swimmers may swim in both age group and open events.
- 6 Super 5 & Flying Squadron age groups are 9/under, 10/11, 12/13, 14/15, 16/over
- 7 Flying Squadron (Event 15) swimming order must be youngest first to oldest last
- 8 Clubs may enter more than one team for each of events 2-14
- 9 All Clubs are to each have a team manager present at the marshalling area to assist with identification of teams
- 10 The age for the Golden Oldies is not less than 30 years, and all entrants must be registered swim club members or parents of club members.
- 11 Events 2-13 must have submitted names and times when entries are made. Names & times for Events 1, 14 & 15 plus any name changes for events 2-13, must be submitted by 6.30pm on Friday 12 June 2010.
- 12 **A swimmer who must be withdraw on the day of the meet as a result of an accident or illness, can only be replaced in all their events and placement by one person. This direct replacement can be made up until 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the meet and will not result in any other consequential team changes.** Failure to swim in the named order will result in disqualification of the team.
- 13 Entry fees will be \$16.00 per team, except for the Golden Oldies which will be free.
- 14 **Entries close at 7.00pm on Wednesday 23 June 2010, no late entries accepted.** Entries to be forwarded to Operations@swimwn.co.nz, and to include a cfile or hvy file, a fee summary. Coach and Team Managers list to be provided.
- 15 **Entry fees of \$16 per event accompanied by a fee summary report should be sent to Viv Morton by 23 June 2010;** 6 Exploration Way, Whitby, Porirua 5024 . Electronic payments can be made to; **WPT 030502-0166158-00**. The conditions of this meet are that all entry fees are to be paid in advance. **Non payment of entry fees, means no swim. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the circulation of psych sheets on Thursday 24 June 2010.**
- 16 Pool door fees are payable on entry as \$2.00 per spectator. Officials and Coach/Managers in the ratio of 1 per 4 Club Teams will be free on sign in at the door. Programmes will be free.
- 17 Medals for places 1-3 inclusive will be presented at the end of the meet, along with the Event Trophies. All team members will be expected to attend the presentation. **Current trophy holders are to ensure that the trophies are cleaned, engraved and returned to Henrietta Latham by Friday 11 June, at Pelorus House, 93 Hutt Park Road, Seaview.**
- 18 The Organisers reserve the right to amend the programme in any way and to refuse entries. Swimming Wellington will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet.
- 19 All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules
