

INTER CLUB LEAGUE

Swimming Wellington invites clubs to enter team/s in the 2011 Inter-club League Series. This competition is open to swimmers 12 years and under



Venue: 4:00pm warm up – 4:45 start
Dates: 10 April Cannon Creek [Host –PCA], 18 June Huia [Host BRK/HUTT]
9 July Huia [Host – UHSC], 24 September Raumati [Host – RAU],

OBJECTIVES

- To encourage club swimmers to swim competitively in a team environment.
- To give opportunity to parents/supporters to be introduced to poolside officiating
- To foster a healthy team competition between clubs in the Wellington region

Eligibility / Team Selection

- Teams shall consist of ten swimmers.
- Ideally teams should have a mix of ages (teams can be mixed boys & girls).
- All swimmers shall be 12 years or under on the date of first meet of the series.
- Teams are allowed two entries in each event. All swimmers must swim in a minimum of 2 individual events, plus 2 relays.
- Recommendation is to keep same team members for the whole season, however clubs may change members if required.

Events

1. 4x25m Breast Relay
2. 50m Backstroke
3. 50m Butterfly
4. 50m Breaststroke
5. 50m Freestyle
6. 4x25m Backstroke Relay
7. 200m Freestyle
8. 4x25m Medley Relay
9. 100m Backstroke
10. 100m Breaststroke
11. 100m Freestyle
12. 100m Ind. medley
13. 10x25m Freestyle Relay

General Guidelines / Rules / Format

- The series will be swum over four meets over a period not exceeding six calendar months.
- This competition will cater for a maximum of 21 teams. Should this series be over-subscribed all clubs will be allowed one team. The organisers will allocated additional teams in the ratio of registered swimmers, or by ballot.
- Organisation is to be kept as simple as possible.
- Swimming is on a CLUB basis.
- Each meet is to be of short duration (est.3.0 hrs) including warm up.
- Race secretaries are to register teams for the whole series by 21 March 2011 with the Operations Manager Operations@swimwn.co.nz
- Race secretaries are to submit swimmers details and times for all events (by TM c/file) when entering their team/s in each meet with the host of each meet. Details will be shown on the website.
- Scoring - Points shall be awarded on a descending scale: 1st place 12 points. 2nd place 10 points 3rd 8 points then descending to 10th 1 point.
- Clubs must appoint a team manager for each team entered.

- All clubs must provide poolside officials as rostered by the meet organiser. These will include three time keepers (not necessarily qualified) a qualified chief timekeeper, a recorder, a runner, a marshal, and personnel to help set up or dismantle pool gear.
- Club League is to be a learning experience for swimmers and officials. Qualified officials will be officiating and are keen to train new people
- All participating clubs must agree to accept the spirit and the rules of the meet in the interests of fostering developing swimmers.

Disqualification/ Dispensation

- Any team swimming a non registered team member and/or who fails to provide officials will be deemed disqualified and will forfeit all points for the meet.

Note:

The meet organiser may grant dispensation from any of the league requirements PROVIDED that this is not granted AFTER THE EVENT. Dispensation will only be granted in exceptional circumstances,

- Team registrations close on 31 March 2011 with the meet organiser, Operations@swimwn.co.nz
Swimmer names for each team are due on the Monday before each meet.
